Physical Description: Hundreds of posters created by artist-collaborators that discuss gender inequity in the gallery system

Project Description: "Gallery Tally is a crowd-sourced, social engagement art project in which 180+ artists from around the world have joined the effort to collect and visualize statistical data regarding ratios of male and female artists in top contemporary art galleries. Artists were invited to make one posters for each gallery, in whatever style or medium they chose. We started with galleries in Los Angeles. The second phase of the project focussed on galleries in New York and other major cities."

This slide presentation shows a selection of 100 of the posters. The entire collection has been exhibited nationally and internationally. In Los Angeles this year, a major installation of all the posters to date were exhibited at LACE gallery.
